**WHAT:**

**HOW:**

The program can be delivered in a number of ways to groups or individuals. The group program can include a training day and focus farm workshops throughout the growing season (dry land 4 workshops and irrigation 6 workshops).

**WHO:**

The program is designed for dryland and irrigated dairy farmers in South Australia. The program can be run by any consultant, field officer, adviser or trainer that has relevant experience in fertiliser management within grazing systems. Groups and individuals can choose to nominate their preferred trainer / consultant to deliver the course.
