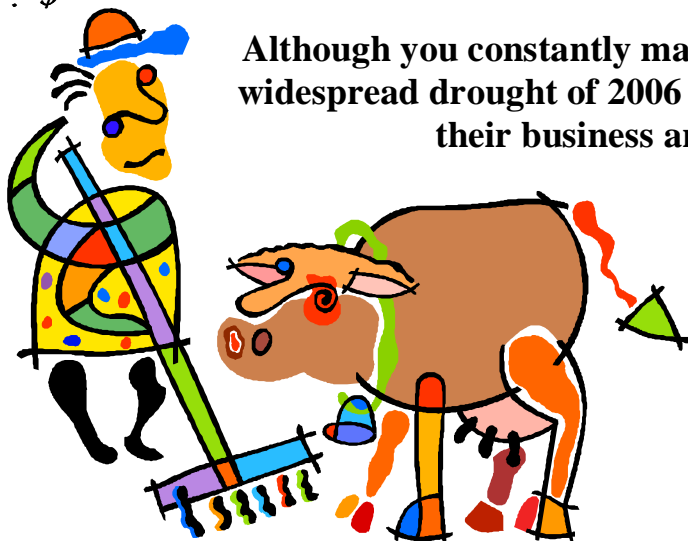


Dairy Farmers - Where to from 2006???
